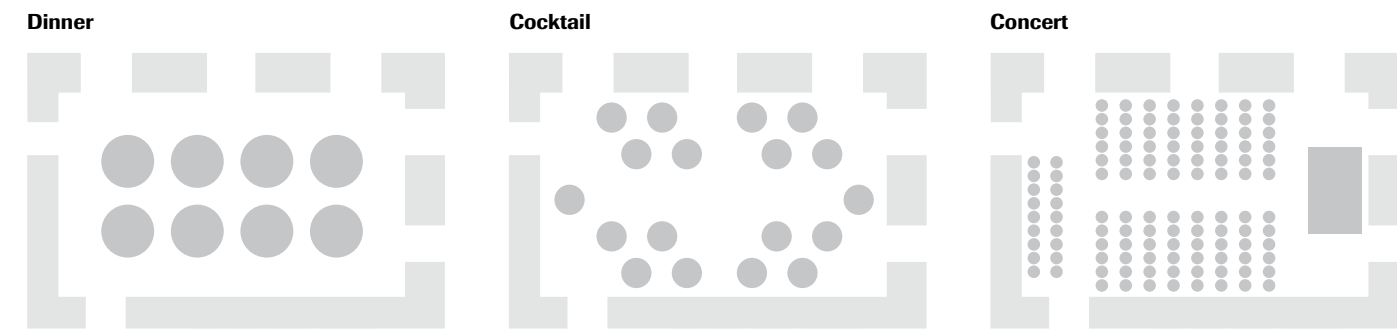


White and Gold Room 1

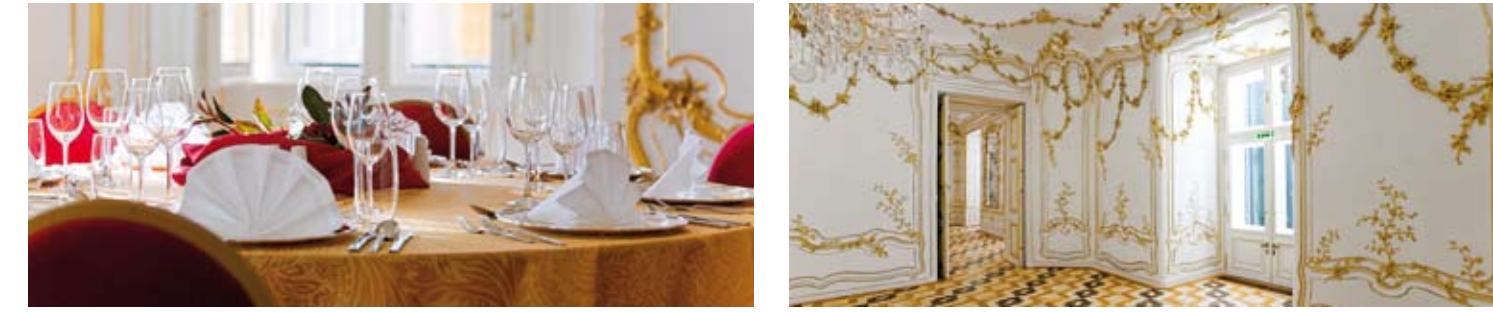

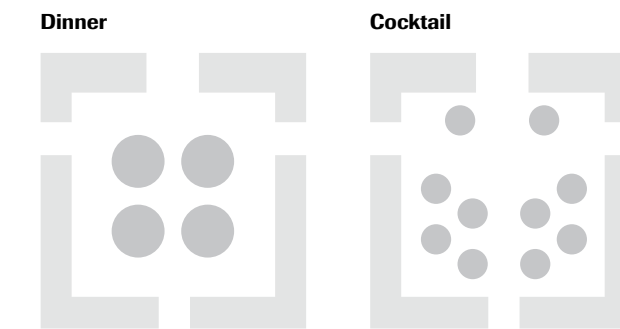

This somewhat smaller room with its elaborately gilded walls can be used as an extension to White and Gold Room 1. Used for the break at a presentation or the interval of a concert, this room can be accessed directly from the catering food handling room.

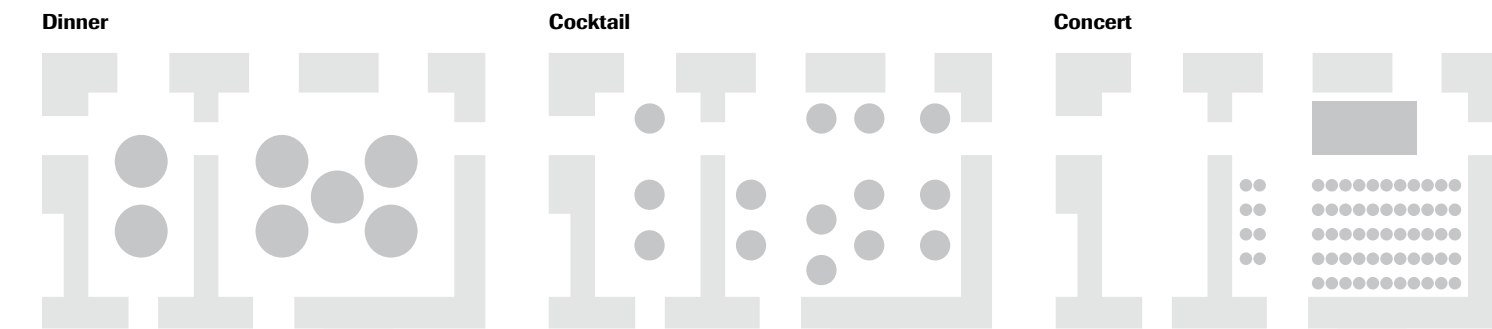

A place to feel at ease in



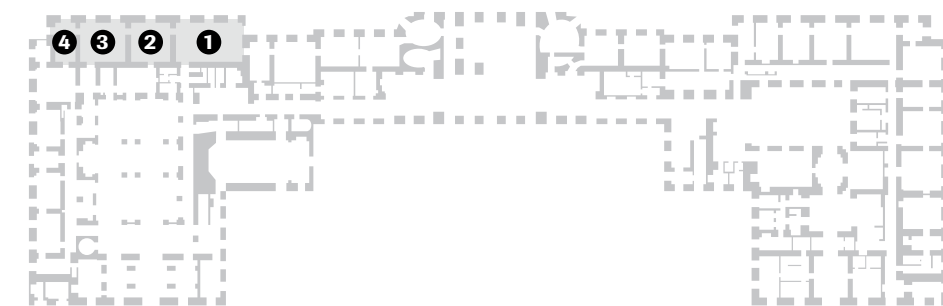
White and Gold Room 3 is ideally suited to smaller events, concerts or civil marriages. White and Gold Room 4 provides an intimate setting for a dinner for two.

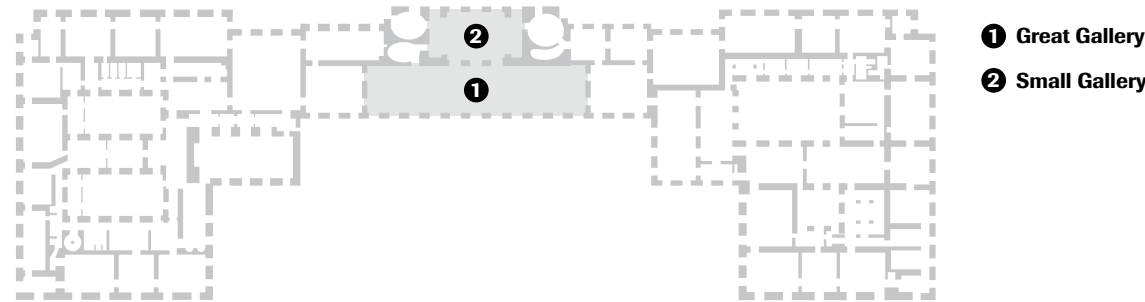

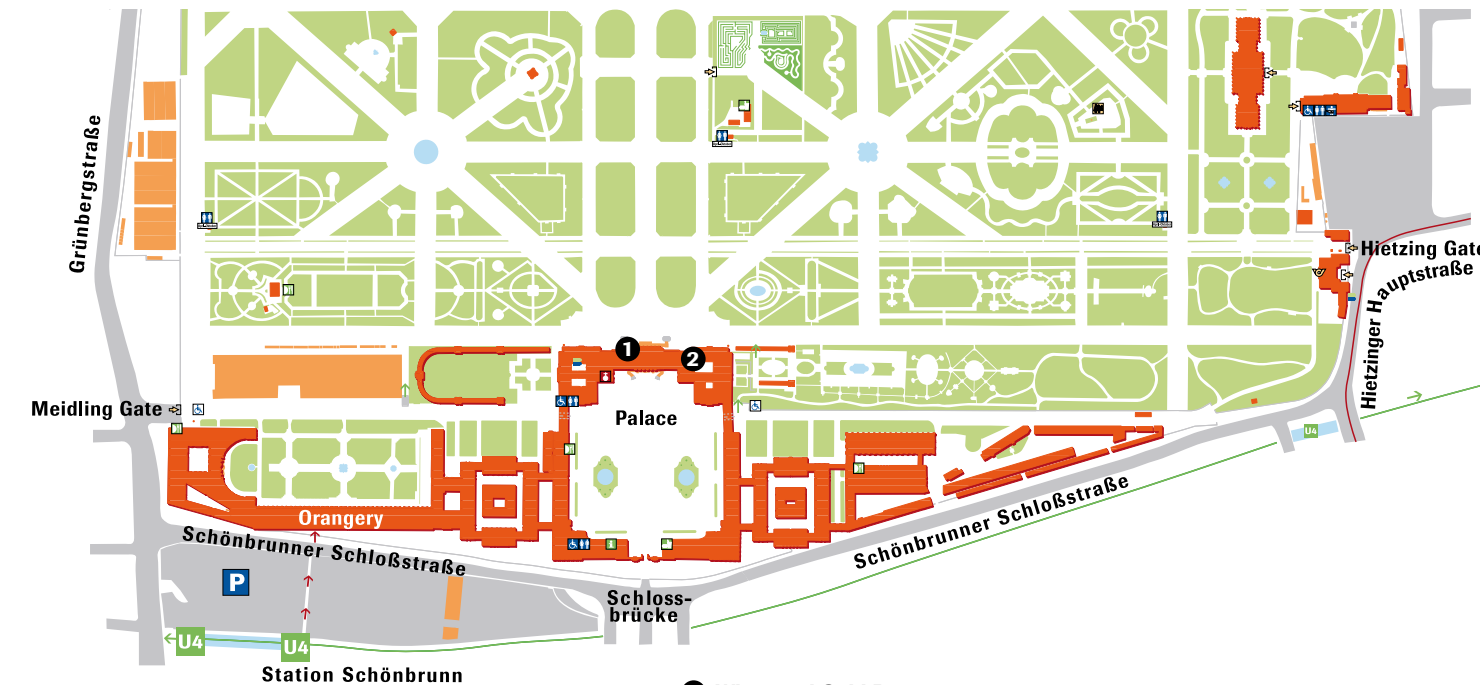

Schönbrunn with its magnificent state rooms is more than just a palace – it's a Baroque synthesis of the arts. In 1996 together with its park it was placed on the list of UNESCO World Cultural Heritage sites.

Whether on the ground floor or the piano nobile – since imperial times the state rooms of the palace have been the setting for official receptions and family celebrations.

Even after the end of the monarchy Schönbrunn remained a favourite venue for state receptions and other formal events. There is hardly a foreign state visitor to Austria who does not include at least a brief visit to the palace in their Vienna itinerary. Among the unforgettable meetings here was the encounter of the American president John F. Kennedy and his Russian counterpart Nikita S. Khrushchev in 1961, or the evening receptions hosted by the Austrian Ministry of Finance and the Latin America summit hosted by the Austrian Foreign Ministry in spring 2006 during the Austrian EU presidency.
